



Christmas Lantern



Supplies needed:

Mason Jar
Floral light string
Glue gun
1 and 1/2" wide ribbon

1/2" wide ribbon
Styrofoam
Floral picks

Instructions:

Using your glue gun, glue the switch of the light string to the back of the jar. Tuck the lights inside the jar. Next, cut some 1 and 1/2" wide ribbon long enough to wrap around the jar and cover the light switch leaving the top of the switch exposed so you can turn it on and off. Glue the ribbon to the jar. Then, cut a piece of styrofoam small enough to fit tightly in the neck of the jar and poke a hole in the middle to put your floral picks into. Insert the floral picks into the hole of the styrofoam then put the whole thing in the jar so that the styrofoam stays at the neck of the jar holding the floral picks in place. Tie a piece of 1/2" wide ribbon around the neck of the jar.
