



Christmas Nightlight



Supplies needed:

Mason Jar (jam size)

1.75" Flameless Candle

Modge Podge

Sponge applicator

Glue gun

1/2" Wide ribbon

Kosher salt

Ornament Topper (can be anything)

Stuffing or fake snow

Instructions:

Pour enough Kosher salt into a container to cover the outside of the jar. Apply a layer of Modge Podge all around the outside of the jar with the sponge applicator. Roll the jar in the salt until it's completely covered. Let dry.

Next, glue the topper to the inside center piece of the jar's lid. If the topper is too big for the outside ring of the lid to go over, glue the topper to the lid while the lid is assembled. If your jar lid is one piece, this does not apply. Glue enough stuffing around the base of the topper to look like snow and hide the lid. Tie a piece of 1/2" wide ribbon around the outside of the lid. Glue in place if desired.

Turn on the candle and place it in the inside of the jar. If the salt is too thick, you may not see enough light shining through. If this happens, simply rub some salt off with your fingers until you see the desired amount of light. Screw the lid onto the jar and you're done!
